### Bus Stops in Rural Areas

In the 103, 105 and 108 Mile areas where there are no designated bus stops, the bus will use flag stops. When you want to catch the bus, find a safe location along the route and wave the bus down. A safe location is one where visibility is good and where the bus can easily pull off the road, such as a driveway or postal box area. Make sure you are visible, especially at night. Carry a flashlight or stand in a well-lit area. To get off the bus, ask the driver to find a safe place to stop.

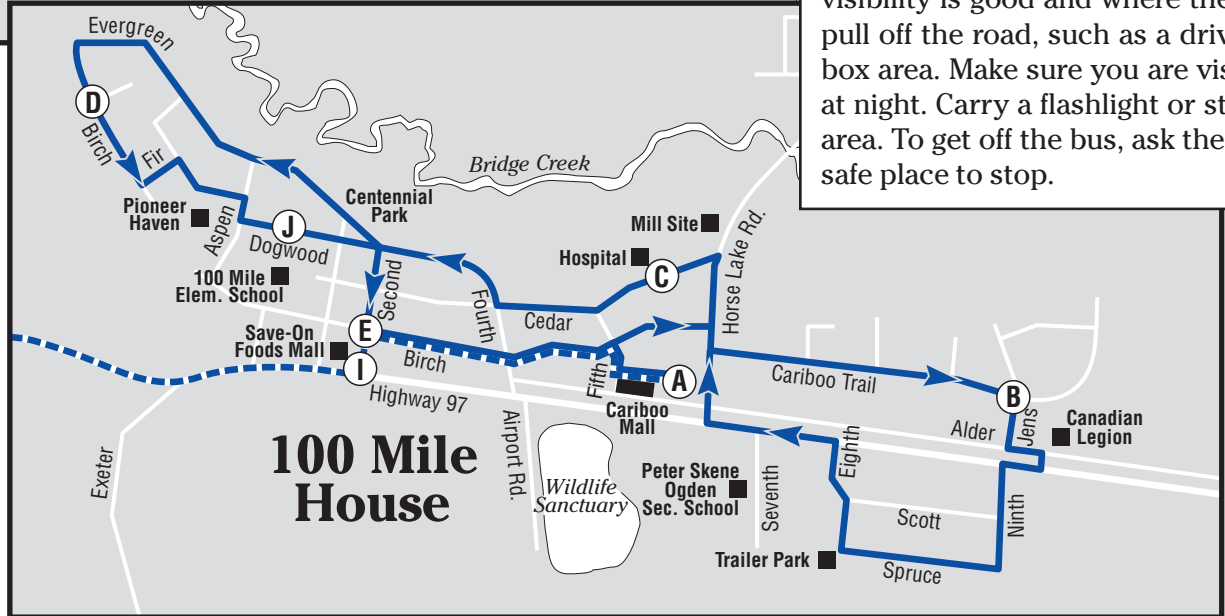

**100 Mile House:** Leaves Second at Birch, Fifth, Cariboo Mall, Cariboo Trail, Jens, Alder, Ninth, Spruce, Eighth, Hwy 97, Horse Lake Rd., Hospital, Cedar, Dogwood, Evergreen, Birch, Fir, Dogwood, Aspen, Dogwood, Save-On Foods, Birch, Second, Fifth, Cariboo Mall.

**108 Ranch (includes 103 Mile):** Leaves Second at Birch, Fifth, Cariboo Mall, Hwy 97, (108 Ranch), Easzee, Gloinnzun, Kitwanga, Telqua, Easzee, Hwy 97, (103 Mile), Park, Dawson, 103 Mile Lake Rd., Hwy 97, Save-On Foods, Birch, Fifth, Cariboo Mall.



### Health Connections to Williams Lake

Health Connections provides transportation options and increases your access to non-emergency medical appointments. When scheduling medical appointments, let the receptionist know you will be using Health Connections. Although medical appointments have priority, everyone can use this service if space is available.

# Welcome to the 100 Mile House Transit Service

Three different kinds of fully accessible Transit Service are available in your community.

The **Community Bus** provides service to major residential areas of 100 Mile House, 103 Mile and 108 Ranch.

**handyDART** provides door-to-door service for seniors and persons with disabilities.

**Rural Transit** provides rides to the general public whenever space is available when the handyDART bus is in your neighbourhood.

In our community the transit service is sponsored by the District of 100 Mile House and the Cariboo Regional District in partnership with BC Transit. The service is operated by LDN Transportation.

## handyDART

**handyDART** is convenient door-to-door transportation for people with disabilities. It is available to those whose disability prevents them from using the conventional bus service.

Passengers must first register with the system. There is no fee for registration. Registrants will be asked to provide their name, address, telephone number, date of birth, doctor's name, address and telephone number, an emergency telephone number and any special medical facts handyDART should be aware of. This information will be kept confidential.

### When the Bus Arrives:

Please be at the accessible pickup point at the time the bus is scheduled to arrive. The driver can wait only five minutes past your scheduled time. Keep in mind that other passengers are waiting.

If you are using a wheelchair, be sure it is equipped with a lap belt. This safety precaution is your responsibility.

Passengers unable to care for themselves who travel without an attendant must be met by a caregiver, parent, or other responsible person at the destination. handyDART is a shared-ride public transit system. Other passengers will be picked up and dropped off enroute.

## Community Bus

**Community Bus Service** is provided by a minibus which is in service throughout the day on regular routes from Monday through Friday. In **100 Mile House**, residents wishing to use transit can board the bus at any posted bus stop. In the **103, 105 and 108 Mile** areas, the bus can be flagged down anywhere on the route shown on the map. If you are unsure of the location of any of these bus stops, please call the dispatcher at **250-395-2834**. A schedule of times and frequencies is included on the reverse side of this Rider's Guide.

### BC Bus Pass Program

For senior citizens and persons with disabilities on restricted incomes, there is an annual bus pass which allows unlimited travel on the Community Bus. For information, call toll-free:

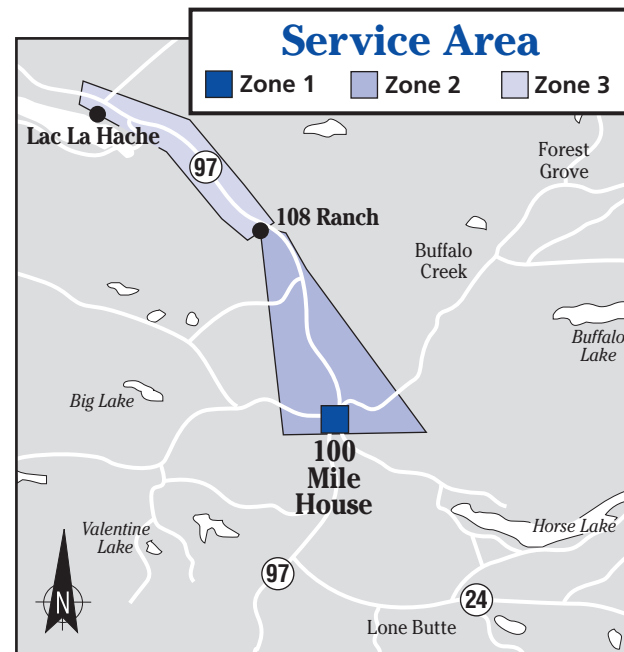

**Rural Bus Service** is available within the specified service areas of the Regional District on specific days when handyDART service is available. Check the Rural Transit Schedule below for operating days for your area and call the dispatcher to arrange your ride.
