| <b>Evergreen Crescent Delegation</b> | <p><b>D1</b></p> <p>A delegation of Evergreen Cr residents appeared before Council to speak to harvesting/fuel mitigation activities along Bridge Creek on District Lot 4180.</p> <p>Ian Kidston outlined the main concerns of residents being the visual quality impacts of the areas adjacent to the creek and on the upper portions of the slope that would be seen from the north. He requested that buffers be maintained along the creek and that logging be stopped in areas with high view-scape impacts. He also had concerns that the many trails on the property would be destroyed as a result of logging and asked that more public consultation be done in future.</p> <p>Gavin McLelland also spoke, outlining anticipated birdlife and wildlife impacts, and called for a buffer of trees to be left. Mr. McLelland wanted more community input.</p> <p>James Lacey spoke next, outlining an emotional attachment to the area. He felt that the District had betrayed his trust.</p> <p>Lastly, Danielle Kidston spoke about various crown land practices, the need for longer term planning for the property, and the level of consultation that should have taken place.</p> <p>Ian Kidston thanked Council for arranging the Special Meeting, stating it shows that Council cares.</p> <p>Mayor Campsall thanked the speakers and all those who came out to the meeting.</p> |
