POLICY

Subject: Equipment Usage – 150 KW Kohler Generator Unit #329

PURPOSE

To establish a policy for the use of equipment by outside organizations.

POLICY

- 1. Municipal equipment may be provided to non-profit, charitable and religious organizations with an operator where the Chief Administrative Officer or the Director of Engineering/Community Services or their designate, is satisfied the equipment is unobtainable from any other local source.
- 2. The outside organization will be responsible for ensuring that there is no damage or vandalism to the equipment during the usage period and will submit a \$200.00 refundable damage deposit.
 - If the equipment is damaged or vandalized during the usage period, the outside organization may be held responsible for the cost of repairs.
- 3. A Municipal operator must operate the equipment or insurance coverage is null and void. Intention is to reduce exposure to liability and pertains primarily to licensed vehicles and equipment.
- 4. A Municipal operator must deliver and pick up all equipment to be used at the organization's event.
