




District of 100 Mile House





WELCOME


Property Taxation



Water & Sewer Fees



Distribution of Property Taxes **





- Includes Cedar Crest Society, Red Cross, Community Club and others.






RESERVES

Total Reserves


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Reserve Balances Total \$13,669,054. as of Dec.31.2019




