REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (RFEI) Implementation of Manual Treatment on Fuel Breaks Updated Feb. 11, 2021

The 100 Mile Development Corporation is interested in obtaining Manual Crew availability for the Implementation of Manual Fuel Treatments in the 100 Mile Community Forest.

- > Manual Fuel Treatments include:
 - Manual cutting and spacing of conifer stems < 12.5 cms dbh, pruning retained live conifers to 3.5 m and piling of cut stems and pruned branches
 - Stems per ha range from approx. 4000 to less than 400
 - Minimum intertree distance is approx. 5 m
 - Minor amounts (less than 30 stems per ha) of felling and bucking of stems greater than 12.5 cms primarily danger trees, and dead pine and fir from bark beetle attack
 - Limbing and bucking of blowdown; piling cut branches and tops
 - Burning debris piles
- > Expressions of interest must include:
 - The number of people available for manual work starting on or about April 15, 2021
 - The type of equipment you have available (e.g. brush saws, chain saws, pole saws)
 - List of projects (similar type of work) completed recently
 - Your availability over the next 6 months to perform the work

Site details will be reviewed with companies that are deemed able to meet the requirements for implementation of Fuel Break Manual Treatments.
