I will assume responsibility for any damage, injury claim, or expense that the Community Forest Licencee faces as a result, directly or indirectly, of the activities carried out in connection with this permission.

I will assume full responsibility for my own actions and the actions of those who accompany me, and save the Community Forest Licencee harmless.
