Nestled on the Fraser Plateau between the Coastal and Rocky Mountain ranges in South Central British Columbia, 100 Mile House is in close proximity to varied ecosystems, including semi-deserts, marshes, grasslands, coniferous forests, and a cedar wet belt. Regional wildlife is diverse, with rainbow trout, great blue herons, black bears, mule deer, moose, and more. In town, you can take a leisurely walk around our Marsh Trail and learn something new about the bird life by viewing the information markers at your own pace.

More sunshine

In 100 Mile House, 73% of available daylight is sunny! Situated 927 metres above sea level, we have mild summers and moderately cold winters that allow you to engage in nearly any outdoor activity you can think of, or to simply relax and take in the beauty of our surrounding environment. If you've got a green thumb, with a 3.5 month-long growing season and a 4B growing zone, you can have your own garden or even a hobby farm.






More time for culture

The World's Largest Cross-Country Skis are a unique roadside attraction that celebrates cross country skiing in our area and offers a great photo opportunity. The skis are 39 feet long with 30-foot ski poles. Wow!
