Subject: Tourism Relief Funding

The Tourism Relief Fund, administered by Western Diversification, is a new funding envelope designed to assist tourism businesses and organizations adapt their operations to meet public health requirements while investing in products and services to facilitate their future growth.

Staff has identified several smaller projects from the Economic Development Strategy, the SFU Rapid Needs Assessment, and the Visitor Centre Destination Strategy, which when combined, appear to meet the WD funding mandate.

The smaller projects include: development of a wayfinding strategy, compiling a tourism inventory, acquisition of videography for key marketing audiences, delivering mobile visitor ambassador services and offering bike tours to enhance the visitor experience (electric bike acquisition).

The total project cost is \$81,265.50 of which 50% funding is available through the Community Transition Capacity Grant (already received), and 50% through the Tourism Relief Fund, if approved. There would be no additional cost to the District.

Subject: National Day for Truth and Reconciliation Day

In June 2021, the federal government announced that September 30th will be a statutory holiday to recognize the tragic history of loss and the lasting effects of Canada's residential school system.

The new statutory holiday responds to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's call to action number 80, which called for the federal government, in collaboration with Indigenous peoples, to establish a National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

September 30 will be a day to honour survivors, their families, and communities, and ensure that public commemoration of the history and legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process.

While the Province of British Columbia has not declared September 30th a statutory holiday in the Employment Standards Act, they have advised public-sector employers to honour the day as obliged to in union collective agreements.

The collective agreement between the District of 100 Mile House and IUOE Local 959 <u>Section A- Statutory Holidays</u> states that employees are entitled to a list of recognized holidays as well as "any other dates proclaimed by the Federal, Provincial, or Municipal Governments."
