Wednesday April 10th, 2024 - The District of 100 Mile House Council endorsed the five-year financial plan at the regular meeting of Council on Tuesday, April 9th, 2024.

With challenges and uncertainties, the District Council approved a 6% rate increase on municipal taxes to ensure the continued provision of essential services and the maintenance of infrastructure.
